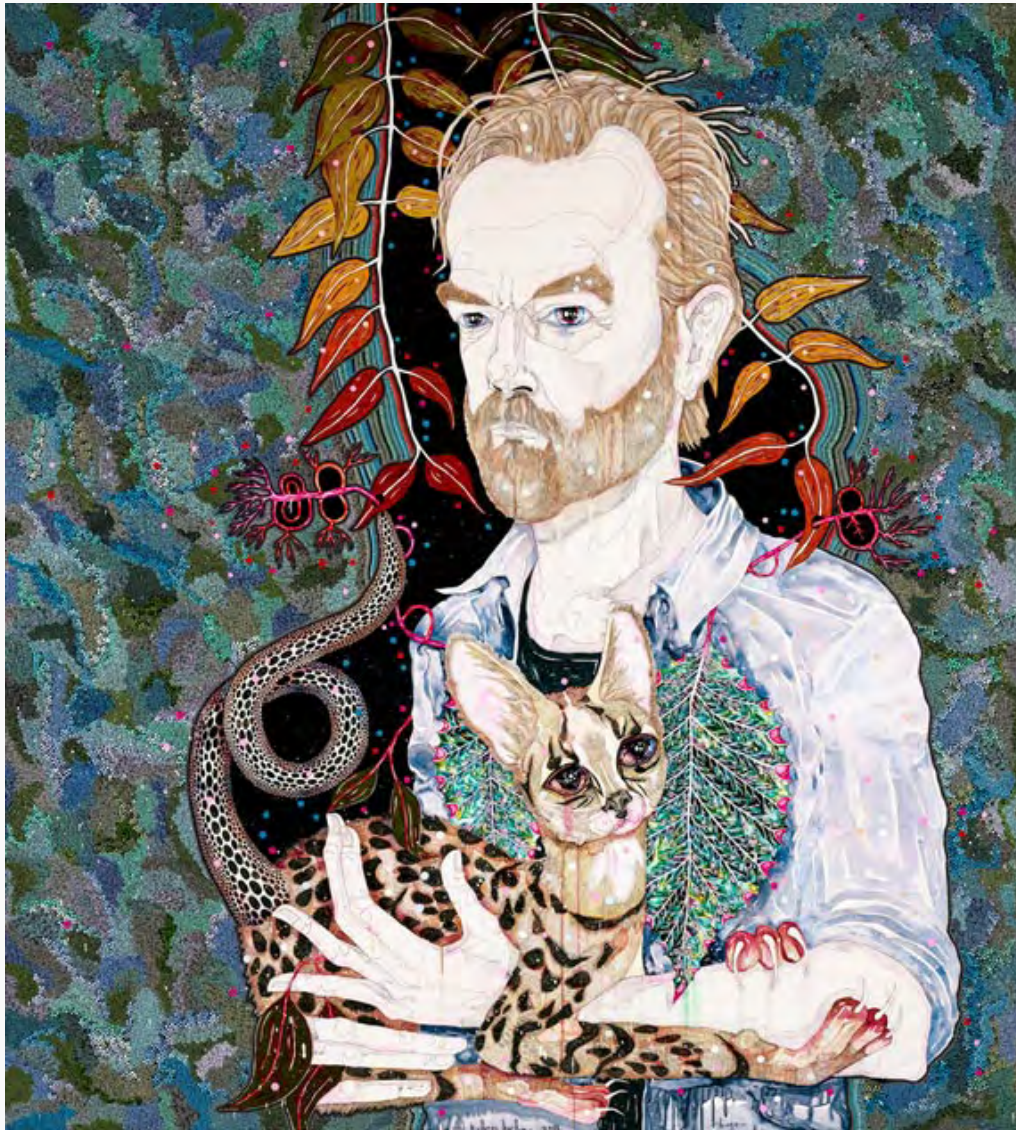

The striking portrait sees the actor surrounded by leaves and carrying a cat, all of which has deep symbolism for both the artist and Weaving.

A long-time admirer of the actor, Barton said most of all she wanted to portray “a sincere, deep, generous and creative soul”.

Barton picked up the Archibald in 2008 with her portrait of herself with her two children. This is the first time a female artist has won the prize twice.
